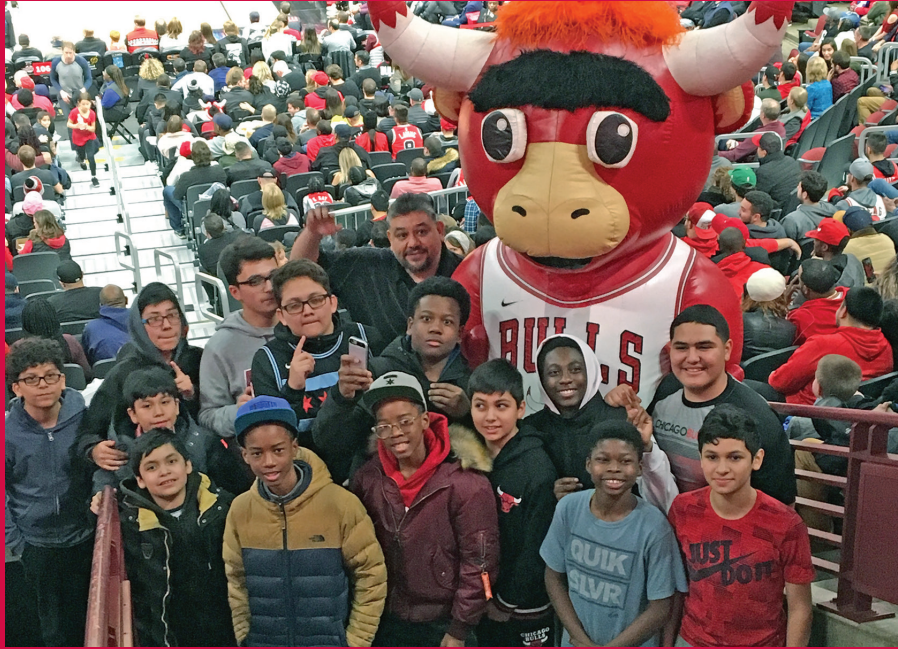

We're Here for the Long Haul

*Neither snow nor rain nor heat nor gloom of night stays these couriers
from the swift completion of their appointed rounds.*

These words from the U.S. Postal Service Creed could easily apply to Midtown Educational Foundation. That's because MEF operates with the long term in mind. Neither snow nor rain, nor pandemics, can turn the staff away from the work of transforming the lives of underserved kids, one by one.

Of course, many nonprofits carried on valiantly this past year, despite the health crisis. The difference was in the richness and strength of MEF program offerings, which were carefully designed to engage students to the fullest degree in both mind and heart. Yes, most of these offerings were delivered on a screen. But parents later reported that their sons and daughters were *excited* to tune in.

One mother wrote: "Ending the school year was a challenge, especially for a nine-year-old sitting behind a desk for hours. But I saw an immediate change of heart in my son after the first Midtown [Center for boys] segment. That same day he shared how excited he was to continue. Well, he wasn't kidding. He made sure to sign in at 9:45 every day because he wanted to be the first one virtually present. It is truly an amazing experience for my son to be a part of Midtown. I can see the growth in him."

MEF donors also remained steadfast. Clearly many of them think long-term, too, having supported MEF year after year. All are listed in the pages of this Report, and we thank them for standing firm in helping advance Chicago's urban youth in a difficult time.

Ours is not a quick-fix program, but one that goes deep. MEF aims to help its students in ways to last a *lifetime*. And nothing, neither snow nor rain nor gloom of night, can divert us from that important work.

Volunteer Profile: *Kristin Barrie*

“**M**y student reminds me of myself at that age,” says Kristin Barrie, a volunteer tutor of four years’ duration at the Metro Achievement Center for girls. Her student is in the sixth grade. “It’s really fun to watch her grow, to bond with her, and to shape goals together—some as simple as resolving to make our beds first thing in the morning.” Kristin has spent three of her four years at Metro with the same student, something the Centers encourage to foster deep friendships.

Professionally, Kristin is an Associate Manager on the Customer Loyalty & Insights Team at Walgreens, gathering market insights particularly in the beauty area. Walgreens is a long-time supporter of MEF, having funded the Walgreens One-on-One tutoring program since 1989. In that thirty-one year period, thousands of underserved students at Midtown and Metro have flourished because of the individual attention they receive from caring adults such as Kristin.



“Metro targets the students in the academic middle, who tend to receive less attention at school than those getting A’s or F’s. Metro is their family outside of family. We all help motivate each other to excel.”

Kristin discovered Metro through a Volunteer Day, when she and a team from Walgreens were sent to the Midtown Center to do some painting. “That day I saw a video about the program. It gave me (and still gives me) goosebumps, so I reached out to learn more about tutoring.” Kristin has since recruited others from Walgreens to join the tutor ranks.

“Since going virtual, Metro has launched an excellent online platform for tutors and students to continue to connect,” she says. “We are also still able to meet for a half-hour before tutoring begins, to mingle with other tutors or learn from guest speakers. I get a lot out of it, but the best part is meeting with my student. Tutoring at Metro is the highlight of my week.”

Volunteer Profile: *Cam Robertson*

Cam Robertson has fortitude. The proof of this claim is that this past fall he started a new job as Global Communications Manager with McDonald's and got married the same week.

Fortitude, of course, is one character trait that the Midtown Center for boys encourages in its students. Cam has volunteered as a tutor in the Walgreens One-on-One Program at Midtown for nearly seven years. While tutors assuredly help students advance academically, Cam observes that Midtown's emphasis on strength of character benefits the students even more. He gives an example. "Adolescents in the One-on-One Program are starting to question their parents' rules and sometimes exhibit behavioral issues at home. Being outside the family, an adult male volunteer can help the student see the importance of respecting their parents and siblings. The student learns to appreciate his family more.



Yes, we want his grades to improve. But the character-building goes much deeper."

In addition to tutoring, Cam serves as Co-Chair of MEF's Auxiliary Board, a support group of young professionals who recruit tutors for the Centers and help raise funds, too. Previous to his McDonald's post Cam worked for the public relations firm Golin, having earned a degree in public relations and political science at DePaul University. There he encountered a PR professor, Bob Kornecki, an enthusiastic advocate and friend of Midtown Educational Foundation who introduced him to Midtown.

After years of one-on-one tutoring at Midtown, Cam observes that "urban youth have a much greater awareness of their surrounding culture than I had expected—politics, current events, sports and more. They are extremely curious, which makes them wide open to learning. That's a great opportunity."

A Summary of MEF Programs

Walgreens One-on-One Program (4th to 6th grade)

Exceptional individuals serve as volunteer tutors/mentors for students. In weekly sessions, they help students with homework, present them with positive role models, and develop in them the study habits associated with high achievers.

Midtown/Metro Achievement Program (7th & 8th grade)

Math, science and English courses prepare students to enter college preparatory high schools and ultimately, college. Character development helps students begin to form a decision framework and vision for their future.

College Orientation Program (9th to 12th grade)

College, career and social readiness are emphasized in this program, which offers ACT prep, rigorous academics, enriching character classes, and help with college and scholarship applications. Students also engage in extracurricular offerings such as apprenticeships, community service projects and cultural and college field trips.

The Parenting Program

Seminars, support groups and individual counseling support parents in their important role as the primary educators of their own children.

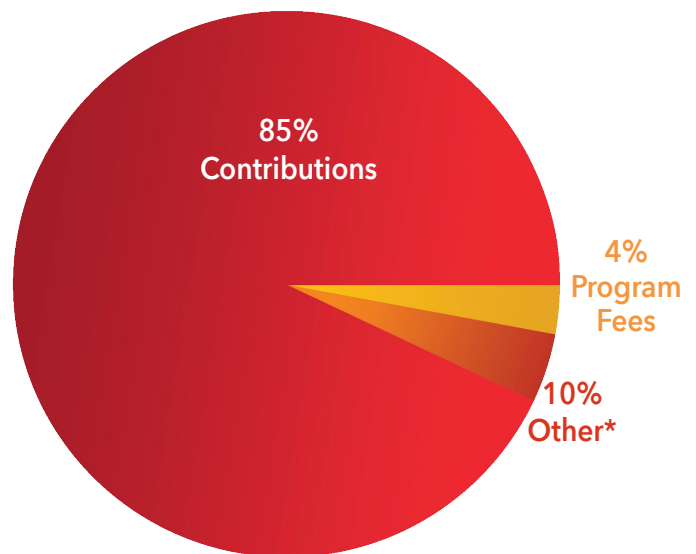

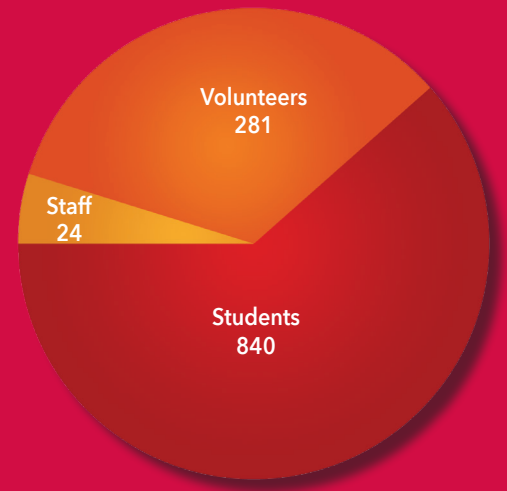
